## 2020-2021 School Supply List

### Third Grade

- 3 packs – of 12 count #2 pencils
- 3 packs – wide ruled notebook paper
- 6 plastic folders with prongs: 1-blue; 1-red; 1-yellow; 1-green; 1-purple; 1-orange
- 3 composition notebooks
- 2 packages of 2 count glue sticks
- 1 pack of 24 count crayons (prefer Crayola)
- 1 pack colored pencils (prefer Crayola)
- 2 packs – pink erasers
- 1 box of freezer bags (Gallon size – girls; Quart size – boys)

### Optional

- 1 box of tissues, disinfectant wipes, hand sanitizer, 1 pair of earbuds for student’s personal use, zippered pencil pouch

### Additional Information

- Only purchase wooden #2 pencils
- Personal pencil sharpeners are not necessary
- It is not necessary for parents to label supplies.

### Face Masks for ALL Students

All students K-12 must wear a face covering that covers both the nose and mouth and fits snugly against the sides of a person’s face with little or no gaps at all times to ensure their own safety and the safety of other students and staff. Students must wear the face covering at all times when on school grounds or district-provided transportation, unless the student is involved in an approved activity when a face covering would not be appropriate. All face coverings must comply with general dress code and school uniform requirements. Students may wear a face shield in addition to a face covering if they choose.
